The mirrors will be provided to you from the Junior League of Racine. The sky is the limit and your creativity is what we are looking for! This mirror will be intended to hang on a wall, as a décor piece or functional mirror. You can add or take away as you see fit. The mirrors will be auctioned at our wine tasting on February 10th and we would like to have the completed mirrors by February 1, 2012. We will host a “people’s choice” competition at the wine tasting for attendees to vote for their favorite mirror and the winner will receive a \$50 prize and recognition. We will also be giving each artist 2 complimentary tickets to attend our wine tasting event on February 10th. (attendees must be at least 21 years of age).

The time sensitive schedule is as follows:

Submit your application, all applications must be received by **January 7, 2012**. Once you have submitted an application you will be sent an email with a picture of all available mirrors, pick the one you want and it will be delivered to you no later than three days after your selection.

Mirrors to be returned to Junior League of Racine no later than, February 1, 2012. We can arrange pick up if necessary

On Friday, February 10, 2012 Junior League will host its annual wine tasting at the Marriot Racine. The mirrors will be on display at the wine tasting where all attendees will be able to vote. At this time a winner will be selected and the award given out.

Rules for “Mirror Mirror on the Wall”

General Design Criteria

You may only submit one mirror.

Any type of media maybe used to decorate the mirror or frame. The frame and/or mirror can be altered in any way. There is no limit on how much you may increase the size of the mirror or frame. The frame can be removed to enhance your design, however the mirror must have the capability to be displayed. Display can include being hung up or displayed on a stand, which must be part of the art work.

No religious, political or social disrespect themes will be permitted. No direct advertising is permitted. The mirror will be auctioned off therefore it must be able to be appropriate for any age.

All mirrors will be provided, however the artist must provide all supplies the mirror. While encouraging you to consider this is a reflection of our past and a look into our future as well as the importance of green design reusing material is encouraged, no stipend will be provided for material.
